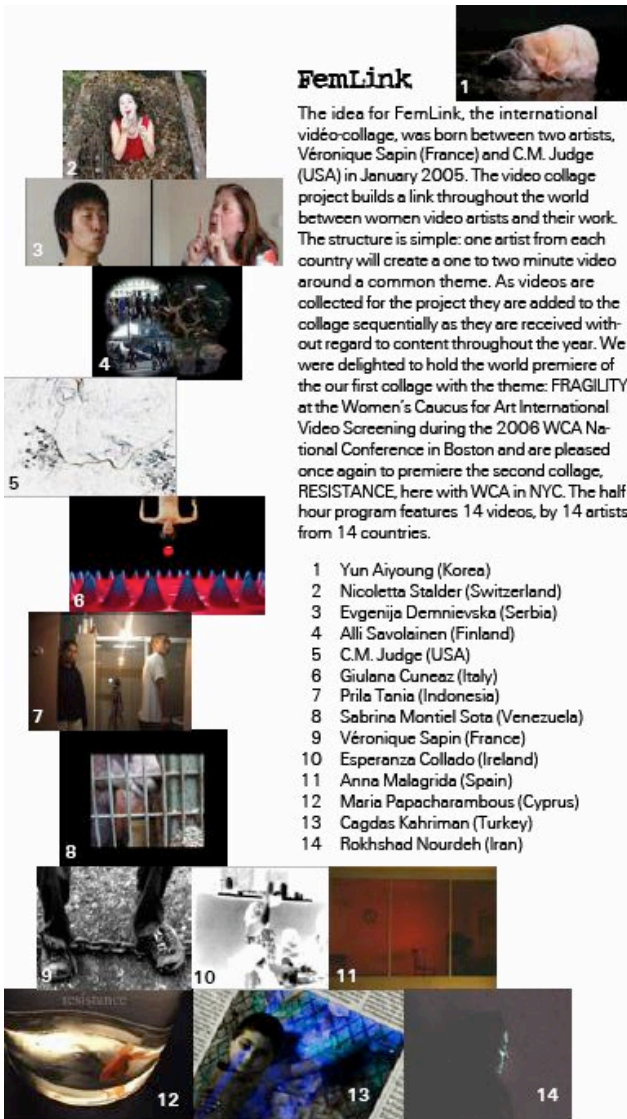


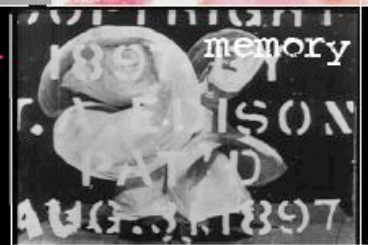
FemLink

The idea for FemLink, the international video-collage, was born between two artists, Véronique Sapin (France) and C.M. Judge (USA) in January 2005. The video collage project builds a link throughout the world between women video artists and their work. The structure is simple: one artist from each country will create a one to two minute video around a common theme. As videos are collected for the project they are added to the collage sequentially as they are received without regard to content throughout the year. We were delighted to hold the world premiere of our first collage with the theme: FRAGILITY at the Women's Caucus for Art International Video Screening during the 2006 WCA National Conference in Boston and are pleased once again to premiere the second collage, RESISTANCE, here with WCA in NYC. The half hour program features 14 videos, by 14 artists from 14 countries.
